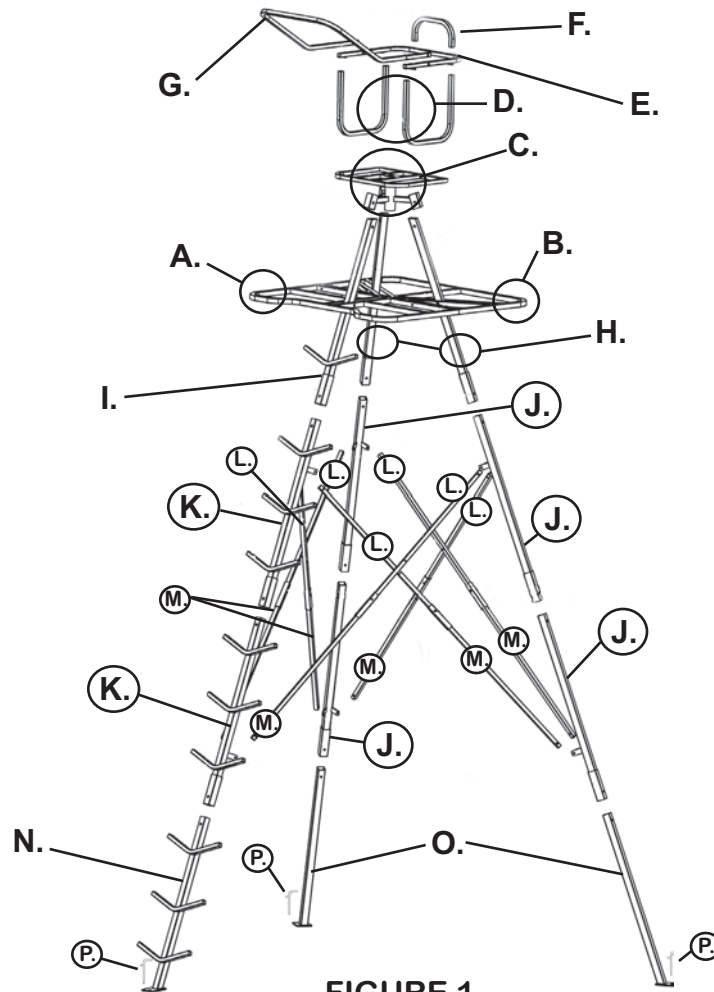

Prior to installing and using your Ol' Man Treestands treestand you must perform some assembly.

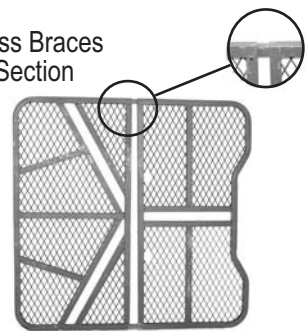

STEP 1: Refer to Figure 1. Locate the standing platform (Female) (A.) and the standing platform (Male) (B.). Insert the male portion of the standing platform (B.) into the female portion of the standing platform (A.) as shown in Figure 2. Bolt together using four (4) 2 3/4" x 5/16" bolts, eight (8) washers and four (4) locknuts as shown in Figure 3.

STEP 2: Refer to Figure 1. Locate the seating platform (C.) and the u-braces (D.). Install the u-braces (D.) onto the standing platform (C.) as shown in Figure 4. Bolt together using four (4) 2 3/4" x 5/16" bolts, eight (8) washers and four (4) locknuts.

STANDING PLATFORM**

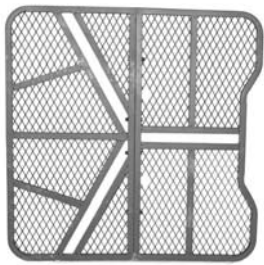


FIGURE 3

STEP 3: Refer to Figure 1. Locate the seating platform top rail (E.). Using four (4) 1 3/4" x 5/16" bolts and four (4) washers attach the seating platform top rail (E.) onto the previously installed u-brace (D.) as shown in Figure 5. NOTE: Make certain the side of the seating platform with the one leg receptacle is facing forward as shown in Figure 5.

STEP 4: Refer to Figure 1. Locate the back rest (F.). Using two (2) 1 3/4" x 5/16" bolts and two (2) washers install on the seating platform top rail (E.) as shown in Figure 6.

STEP 5: Refer to Figure 1. Locate the folding shooting rail (G.). Install the folding shooting rail (G.) onto the seating platform top rail (E.) using two (2) 2 3/4" x 5/16" bolts, four (4) washers, two (2) nylon washers and two (2) locknuts as shown in Figure 7. NOTE: The nylon washers should be placed between the folding shooting rail (G.) and the seating platform top rail (E.) to minimize any noise when the folding shooting rail (G.) is raised or lowered.

RAIL INSTALLED

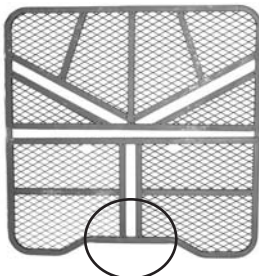

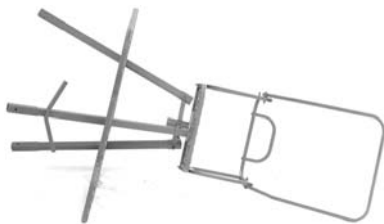


FIGURE 11
TURN ASSEMBLY ON SIDE

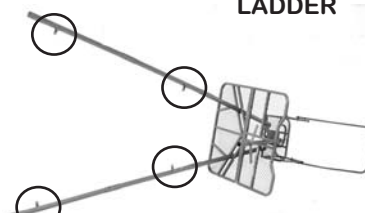


FIGURE 12

STEP 6: Refer to Figure 1. Locate the previously assembled standing platform (A. & B.). Please refer to Figure 8. The front of the standing platform has the indentation in it. Locate the two (2) upper platform supports (H.) and the upper ladder (I.). NOTE: The upper ladder has one (1) rung.

STEP 8: Install the two (2) upper platform supports (H.) and upper ladder (I.) as shown in Figure 9 using three (3) 4 1/4" x 5/16" bolts, six (6) washers and three (3) locknuts. DO NOT TIGHTEN YET.

STEP 9: Refer to Figure 1. Locate the seating platform that you previously assembled. Install the seating platform assembly onto the upper platform supports (H.) and the upper ladder as shown in Figure 10. Attach using three (3) 1 3/4" x 5/16" bolts, six (6) washers and three (3) locknuts. NOTE: Go back and tighten the previously installed hardware using two (2) 13mm wrench (not included).

STEP 10: Refer to Figure 1. Locate the four (4) bracketed support posts (J.). With the help of two (2) other adults, gently turn your previously assembled seating platform assembly on its side as shown in Figure 11. Install the bracketed support posts (J.) onto the two (2) upper platform supports (H.) as shown in Figure 12. Use four (4) 2 3/4" x 5/16" bolts, eight (8) washers and four (4) locknuts to secure the bracketed support posts (J.) as shown in Figure 13. Make certain the brackets are facing inward as shown in Figure 12.

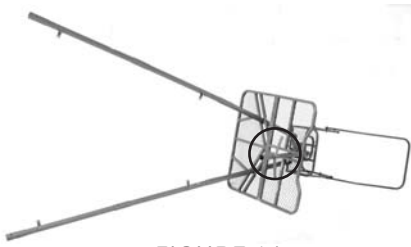

STAND TURNED ON IT SIDE

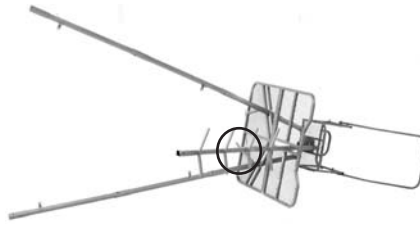


FIGURE 15

LADDER SECTION

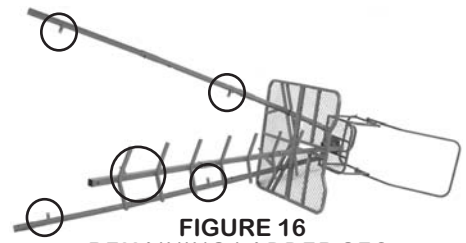


FIGURE 16

STEP 11: Refer to Figure 1. Locate the two (2) bracketed ladder sections (K.) (3-rungs). With the help of two (2) other adults, gently turn your previously assembled seating platform assembly on its side so the previously installed upper ladder section (I.) is accessible as shown in Figure 14. Insert the male portion of one (1) bracketed ladder section (K.) into the female portion of the previously installed upper ladder section (I.) as shown in Figure 15. Now repeat this for the remaining bracketed ladder section. Use two (2) 2 3/4" x 5/16" bolts, four (4) washers and two (2) locknuts to secure the bracketed ladder section (K.) as shown in Figure 15. Make certain the brackets are facing inward as shown in Figure 16.

STEP 12: Refer to Figure 1. Locate the six (6) male cross braces (L.) and the six (6) female cross braces (M.). Insert the male cross braces (L.) into the six (6) female cross braces (M.). Secure each set of braces using one (1) 1 3/4" x 5/16" bolt, two (2) washers and a locknut as shown in Figure 17.

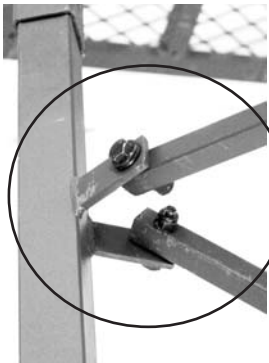


FIGURE 17
SECURE CROSS BRACES

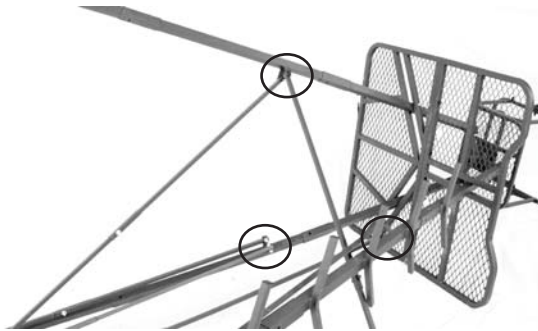


FIGURE 18

BRACKETS

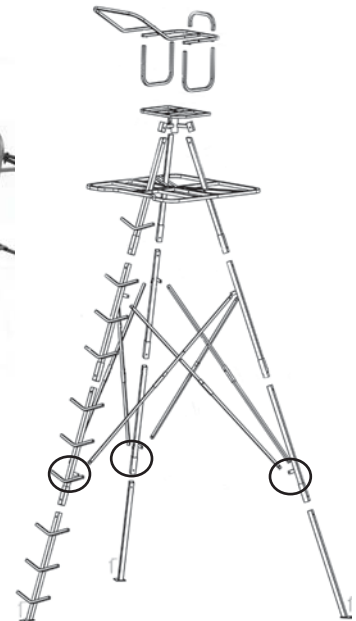


FIGURE 19

AS SHOWN

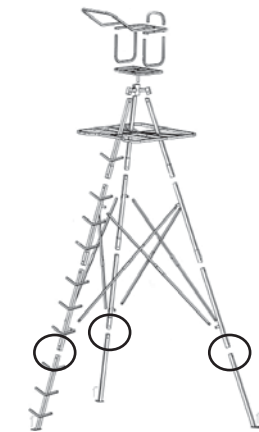


FIGURE 20

LEGS

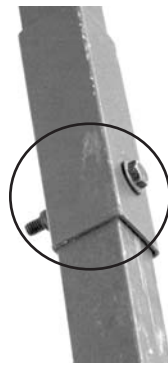


FIGURE 21

STEP 13: With all six (6) cross braces assembled, it is now time to install them onto the tripod. **PROPER INSTALLATION OF THE CROSS BRACES IS VERY IMPORTANT.** Install the six (6) cross braces ON THE INSIDE of the welded brackets on the upper brackets as shown in Figure 18. With the six (6) cross braces installed on the upper brackets, install the opposite ends of the cross braces to the lower welded brackets as shown in Figure 19. Attach using one (1) 1 3/4" x 5/16" bolt, two (2) washers and one locknut per union as shown in Figure 17.

STEP 14: Refer to Figure 1. With all six (6) cross braces installed, locate the lower ladder section (N.) and the two (2) lower legs (O.). Insert the lower ladder section (N.) into the previously installed bracketed ladder section (K.) as shown in Figure 20. Insert the lower legs (O.) into the previously installed bracketed support posts (J.) as shown in Figure 20. Secure these connections using one (1) 1 3/4" x 5/16" bolt, two (2) washers and one (1) locknut per union as shown in Figure 21.

STEP 15: Go back now and make certain all the hardware has been tightened.

INSTALLING OL' MAN TREESTANDS 13' DELUXE TRIPOD



WARNING! You must have at least three (3) adults to install and/or remove this ladder treestand. Failure to follow these instructions may result in serious injury or death!

You must practice installing, setting-up and using this product(s) at ground-level prior to attempting to use it at heights above ground-level. Once you have become thoroughly knowledgeable and comfortable with this Ol' Man Treestands product(s) setup, installation and use at ground-level - you're now ready to use it at heights above ground-level. Failure to follow these instructions may result in serious injury or death!



WARNING! You must check the ground under the treestand to make sure it is firm and level. Sloping ground or uneven surfaces (e.g., one foot on a rock) can cause your ladder to tilt or shift off the tree as you climb. Failure to follow these instructions may result in serious injury or death!



WARNING! DO NOT use this, or any other Ol' Man Treestands product(s) to climb utility poles, telephone poles, structural columns or any other man-made structures. STEP 1: With your 13' Deluxe Tripod assembled as previously described, locate a suitable place to erect your treestand. The ground must be level and firm. The stand placement location must be free of rocks, gravel, sand, mud, under brush, snow, frozen ground, ice, branches and any other commodities that might make for an unlevel and/or may inhibit the ability to install the 13' Deluxe Tripod on level and secure footings.

STEP 2: With the help of two (2) other adults, lay the 13' Deluxe Tripod on its side on the ground. Once your stand location has been determined, with the help of two (2) other adults, rotate the 13' Deluxe Tripod into a standing position. Once erected, make certain that the standing platform and seat assembly are level.

STEP 3: After installing your 13' Deluxe Tripod on level and firm ground, locate the leg stakes (P.) as shown in Figure 1. Locate the leg stake holes in each of the lower leg sections (L.) Install the four (4) leg stakes (O.) by placing one (1) per leg section.



WARNING! Failure to install the leg stakes as outlined in this Instruction Manual may result in serious injury or death!



WARNING! Prior to climbing your 13' Deluxe Tripod, make sure that all the ladder sections and support posts are firmly connected. Failure to follow these instructions will result in serious injury or death!



WARNING! Prior to attempting to climb a ladder stand for the first time, make certain the feet of the tripod are firmly planted on solid, level ground. If they are not firmly planted on level ground, DO NOT climb the tripod. With the help of three (3) adults, lower the stand and find a suitable location to safely install the ladder stand. Failure to follow these instructions may result in serious injury or death!



WARNING! You must lean forward when climbing to keep the stand centered and secure. DO NOT lean backwards when climbing! Failure to follow these instructions will result in serious injury or death!



WARNING! When climbing, always maintain three points of contact as you ascend (climb up) and while descending (climb down). Failure to maintain three points of contact puts the user at serious risk of bodily injury. Failure to follow these instructions will result in serious injury or death!
